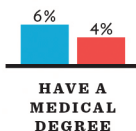
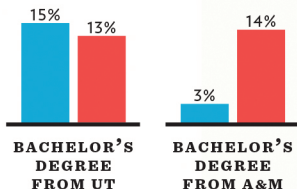
Which legislator traveled the farthest to go to school? It depends on what you mean by "go to school."

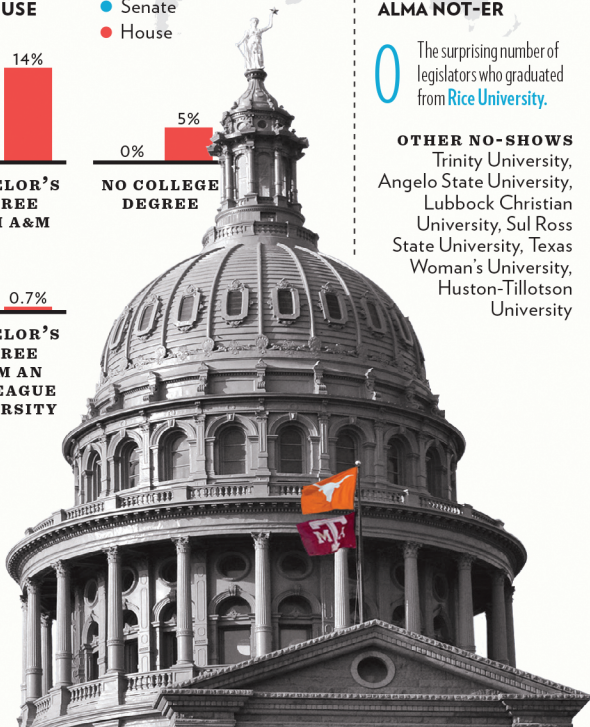
